



## Information about our use of cookies

At The Care Trust, we work hard to ensure that you can use our websites with confidence that all information you give us is safe and secure. This Fair Play To You website/app is operated by The Care TrustDAC (“We”, “Us” or “Our”). This page, together with our Data Privacy Statement, details our use of cookies on this website/app. We may update this policy from time to time by updating this page.

Our Fair Play To You website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website. This helps us to improve your experience when you browse our website and also allows us to improve our website. To review your cookie acceptance, please click the link here: [Cookie Settings](#)

### What are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are stored by the browser (e.g. Internet Explorer, Chrome or Safari) on your computer or mobile. You can think of Cookies as providing a ‘memory’ for the website. They allow websites and apps to store things like user preferences, enabling you to navigate more efficiently between webpages, login information and generally improving your online experience. Each cookie is unique to your web browser. It will usually contain some anonymous information such as a unique identifier and the site/app name and some digits and numbers. Cookies can either be session (which are stored temporarily during a browsing session and are deleted from the user’s device when the browser is closed) or persistent (which are saved on your computer for a fixed period and are not deleted when the browser is closed and are used to manage return visits). We may also use tracking beacons (also known as "clear GIFs" or "pixel tags") or similar technologies on our Site to enable us to know whether you have visited a web page or received a message.

We use the following categories of cookies:

### Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies are essential and allow you to move around the website and use its features, such as accessing secure areas. Without these cookies, services you’ve asked for can’t be provided. These cookies don’t gather information about you that is used for marketing or remembering where you have been on the internet.

These Cookies are required for certain features of our websites to work. For example, Cookies are required to remember if you are signed in as you browse around our websites. These cookies are necessary for the website to function and cannot be switched off in our systems. They are usually set in response to actions made by you that amount to a request for services, such as setting your privacy preferences, logging in or filling in forms. They are also used by us to assist in our obligation to prevent problem gaming in line with our Contributor Code of Practice. You can set your browser to block or alert you about these cookies, but some parts of the site will not then work.

### Functional cookies

These help us personalise your experience by remembering your preferences and settings. These cookies enable the website to provide enhanced functionality and personalisation. They may be set by us or by third party providers whose services we have added to our pages. These cookies are required in order to use Webchat functions of our website. No information is gathered or stored unless you interact with these features.

### Analytics and performance cookies

These help us understand how people are using our websites, so we can better serve them. We may sometimes get other companies to analyse how people are using our websites. These companies might set their own performance cookies. Some examples of how we use these Cookies are: Collecting information on which web pages visitors go to most often; making sure that our Sites are working properly.

### Targeting cookies

These cookies allow us to monitor traffic sources so we can identify where and how users enter our website. They help us to know which advertising attracts certain visitors and see how visitors move around the website.

Targeting Cookies are used by us to assist in our obligation to prevent problem gaming in line with our Contributor Code of Practice.

Because Targeting Cookies also track the effect of our advertising, you can disable them at any time (we keep our default settings under regular review to reflect emerging law and guidance in this area). If you choose to disable these cookies, we will still use Strictly Necessary Cookies as outlined above.

Users can set their browsers to accept or reject cookies. You can opt out of Google Analytics for Display Advertising and customise Google Display Network ads using the Ads settings (<https://www.google.com/settings/u/0/ads> or opt out using Google Analytics opt-out browser add-on (<https://tools.google.com/dlpage/gaoptout/>

We continually update our technology so that we can provide you with the most efficient and useful tools. These updates include how we use cookies, placement of new cookies as well as the extension to older cookies to make them more efficient so that we can provide you with a better service. This list will be updated from time to time, you should check back on a regular basis for changes.

What happens to Cookies that have been downloaded in the past? You can delete existing cookies from your browser otherwise; they will remain until they expire. Once you have disabled a cookie, we will stop using it to gather information.
